State-funded Behavior Add-On and Form Revision

The purpose of this email is twofold; to remind boards the state-funded behavior add on form must be submitted to DODD at the request of the team (specifically, board cannot deny the individual/guardian) and inform you the revised state-funded behavior add-on fillable form has been posted to the DODD website under Forms/Prior Authorization, Training, and County Boards/MSS Training Resources.

What's new with the state-funded behavioral add-on?

- Six requests have been received and authorized
- One withdrawn (miscommunication between provider and SSA with untimely submittal)
- One ineligible (did not qualify as “new”, previous add-on with no “gap”)
- Questions from the field indicate not all boards are familiar with the process – DODD encourages you to visit the links below for assistance

What's new on the form?

- The board does not need to complete the HPC and Community Respite “units” section for individuals enrolled on Level One and Individual Options.
- The board does not need to complete “budget adjustments” after initial DODD authorization because MSS will capture the costs.
- The board does need to complete the Community Respite “units” section for individuals enrolled on the SELF waiver because MSS does not do the calculations for units or unit type, currently the board inserts the dollar amount associated with service code.
- The board does need to complete “budget adjustments” after the initial DODD authorization for individuals enrolled on the SELF waiver because MSS will not be able to capture the costs.
