Timely Filing Reminder for ICF-IID Providers

Beginning with July 1, 2015 dates of service (DOS), Intermediate Care Facilities for Individuals with Intellectual Disabilities (ICFs-IID) have been responsible for submitting claims to the Ohio Department of Medicaid (ODM) when seeking per diem payment. ICF-IID claims must follow all submission requirements noted in Ohio Administrative Code (OAC) Rule 5123:2-7-15, including timely filing requirements. This means that claims with July 1, 2015 DOS and beyond that are submitted outside of the timely filing requirements will be denied for payment.

Please take time to review the timely filing requirements referenced above to ensure that your claims are submitted timely in order to be considered for payment. ICF-IID claims must be submitted within 365 days of the last DOS on the claim in order to be considered timely (additional time is allowed for resubmitting denied claims). Claim adjustments for an increased payment must be submitted within 180 days of the payment being adjusted, even if adjusting for changes in patient liability. (Providers may void paid claims or adjust paid claims for a lesser payment amount without the limitation of timely filing.)
