Subject: Ordering, Referring, Prescribing (ORP) Requirements

Effective April 1, 2015, most claims submitted to the Medicaid Information Technology System (MITS) required the name and national provider identifier (NPI) number for the entity that ordered, referred, or prescribed the Medicaid-funded service.

Claims submitted for the following TDD services must include the name and NPI number of the ordering, referring, or prescribing (ORP) clinician.

- All nursing services, including those provided by independent providers and home health agencies;
- Personal care aide services provided by Medicare-certified or otherwise accredited home health agencies; and
- All claims for durable medical equipment (DME).

Independent TDD providers (provider type 25) and agency providers (provider type 45) that are NOT Medicare-certified or otherwise accredited home health agencies must submit a “**UT**” modifier on **ALL** other claims. This includes all claims for personal care aide services provided by independent providers or DODD-certified agencies that are not home health agencies. Claims without the UT modifier will be denied with an ORP edit (1121, 1122, etc.). ORP information cannot be submitted in lieu of or in addition to modifier UT on TDD claims from independents and DODD-certified agencies that are not Medicare-certified or otherwise accredited home health agencies.
