2016-2017 Budget	Every year my team will talk with me about my <b>choices</b> , including the choice to get a WAIVER and move into the <b>community</b> .	If you want to live in an ICF with 8 people or less – you <b>can</b> as long as you can have your own bedroom or share a room with only one other person.	You will be assigned an SSA at a CBDD.	If you have more than <b>2 people per bedroom</b> , you must submit a <b>plan</b> about how you will get to 2/bedroom. You can't <b>admit</b> anyone until you have 2/bedroom; you can continue to <b>operate</b> if you submit and comply with your plan.  DODD will redesign the <b>ICF reimbursement</b> system to focus on <b>quality</b> and <b>outcomes</b>
	There may be a <b>waiver</b> available if you want to move.	If you want to live in an ICF with 9 or more people where you have your own bedroom or share a room with only one other person, you <b>may be</b> able to. Talk to your CBDD and they will tell you about your <b>choices</b> , including the choice to get a <b>waiver</b> and live in the <b>community</b> .	There may be a <b>waiver</b> available.	If you want to <b>convert</b> some/all of your beds to waiver: <ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>• Cost report adjustment</li> <li>• Date of discharge payment</li> <li>• Franchise fee adjustment</li> <li>• Waiver rate add-on</li> <li>• Waiver rate increase</li> </ul>
		If you want to live in an ICF with 9 or more people with <b>more than 2</b> people in a bedroom, you won't be able to unless the ICF can make sure there are only 1 or 2 people in a bedroom.		If you have 16+ beds: <ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>• If you convert <b>some</b> of your beds, some of your <b>debt</b> may be forgiven</li> <li>• If you convert <b>all</b> of your beds, all of your <b>debt</b> may be forgiven</li> </ul>
	If you want to move and need help with <b>rent</b> or other <b>expenses</b> , there may be money available.	There may be a <b>waiver</b> available if you choose to live in the <b>community</b> instead.
