### For Use by Adult Day Support, Vocational Habilitation, and ICF Day Programs

**To be completed for**

- All personnel and participants of out-of-home Adult Day Support (ADS), Vocational Habilitation (VH), Intermediate Care Facility (ICF) Day Programs, **upon arrival**, before proceeding to the general service area.

**Directions**

- 1) Indicate the time and date of each symptom monitoring log.
- 2) In the symptom boxes, write "Y" for yes or "N" for no for symptoms experienced.
- 3) Only document symptoms for which there is no known cause. For example, seasonal allergy symptoms, chronic cough, etc. would not need to be documented.
